

RAJASTHAN STATE JUDICIAL ACADEMY, JODHPUR

The Academy calendar for State Judicial Academy could not be finalized due to non availability of personal building and appropriate infrastructure for conducting regular in-service judicial learning programme.

However, this Academy felt the need of imparting continuous judicial education & regular workshop/seminars are conducted in the District Headquarter forming clustered of district in a large district where Courts are functioning more than 30. Till September, 2007, the Academy has conducted 11 in-service Seminar/Workshops at various District Headquarters. Initially, these Workshop/Seminars were being conducted at 20 District Headquarters, in each Quarter (every 3 months). However, from year 2006, they are being conducted at 13 District Headquarters, in bloc of 04 months.

Recently, during the month of August & September, 2007 the Second bloc workshop/seminar has organized at 13 District headquarters on following subjects :-

- Critical analysis of Domestic Violence Act, 2005
- Prevention of Crime against Women - Role of subordinate judiciary

After the National Judicial Academy conducted "Second Regional Programme on Techniques & Tools for Delay & Arrear Reduction", at Bhopal from 02nd to 04th February, 2007. The Academy has also undertaken special seminars on "**Delay & Arrear Reduction - Techniques & Tools**", at 05 Division Headquarters (Jodhpur, Jaipur, Bikaner, Udaipur & Kota) during the months of May to August' 2007.

The main theme of the Conference was how leadership can be exhibited in court management; especially with reference to avoid delay in disposal of cases and how arrears can be reduced. It was also expressed by Hon'ble dignitaries that similar exercise can be taken up by State judiciary and State

Judicial Academies at their own level by calling such seminars at district as well as State level.

Apart from these, as entrusted by Hon'ble High Court, the Academy has also undertaken task of making proposals for nomination of judicial officers to various training programmes at National Judicial Academy, Bhopal, in 2005 and 2007.

Future Training programmes and plans :-

In immediate future, the Academy has planned to hold following Special Seminars:

Seminar of judges of Fast Track courts

The seminar for Vision & Training Needs of judges of Fast Track Courts will be scheduled on 28th October, 2007 at Jodhpur Headquarter. In this seminar following aspects will required to consideration :-

- Functional difficulties of Fast Track Courts
- Rationalization of workload
- Camp Courts- problems & suggestions
- Utility of Fast Track courts in discharge of other judicial functions.

In-service judicial officers training programme :-

For the continuing and in-service Judicial Officer training, the Third Bloc workshop/seminar on the subject "Investigation of offences covered under Information Technology Act, 2000 & Appreciation of Electronic Evidence and Digital Signature" will be organized during the month of November & December' 2007

Induction training programme for newly recruited Rajasthan Judicial Services Officers :-

Upon ensuing appointment of new officers to Rajasthan Judicial Service, the Academy will be imparting one year Induction Training to these new entrants to the Service.

Judicial staff training

The task of training the judicial staff, long felt and repeatedly emphasized in Chief Justices' Conference, will be regularly undertaken by the Academy after construction of the building and implementation of requisite infrastructure facilities. Meanwhile, the Academy plans to conduct in situ refresher workshops once in 04 months.
